Dear Motor Medics,

I am on the fence about installing a replacement engine in my Silverado truck or just selling it to a yard for scrap. I have owned it for ten years and really like it and if the engine would not have failed, I would not even think of getting a different vehicle. I have already spent a lot of money on repairs the past two years including a new transmission and brakes and tires to name just a few. When should you keep a vehicle verses scraping one?

We advise people on this subject carefully. In the end it is your decision but here is what we have to offer. First you need to look at the value of your vehicle assuming it had a good running engine. What are those vehicles selling for? Once that is established find out what it will cost to repair yours with a new or low mileage used engine and do some math. Selling a vehicle for scrap is one of the lowest prices you will get and often you can put a used engine in and recover the cost of the engine plus a decent amount for the vehicle when running correctly. You have already put a lot into it, so you know the vehicle well. If your cost to fix it is comparable to buying another similar model vehicle, you are likely better off than buying someone else's problem.

In respect to COVID-19, Pantry clients will receive items that have been pre-


