FLUSHING NOTICE


The City of Brandon will be flushing water mains from Monday, May 23rd through the end of June, 2022 or until flushing is complete.

Flushing hydrants is needed to ensure they are in proper working condition for fire protection and to remove any mineral deposits that may have accumulated in the water mains.

Residents should be advised that the change in water flow patterns resulting from hydrant flushing may stir up mineral deposits in home services.

During hydrant flushing, it is not uncommon for residents to periodically experience discolored water, pressure change, and/or an increased chlorine odor. Homeowners are advised to exercise care in their laundry operations and to check the water for clarity before use.

Motorists also are advised to stay clear of the streams of water coming from the hydrants.



Ask the Motor Medics®

Automotive Advice from The Under the Hood® Show

Dear Motor Medics,
We have a 2008 Chevrolet Tahoe and when it was just a year old, we got a new puppy. The first time we left it alone while we went inside a restaurant to eat, she decided to eat the Tahoe. She chewed the back of the rear seat and the corner off of the plastic trim too. The vehicle is in great shape with 70,000 miles and we want to sell it, but with a large hole in the seat and the damage to the plastic side trim it's making the sale very difficult. We checked with the dealer and they are telling us they can repair it at a cost of over \$3500.00 parts and labor and our insurance will not cover repairs. Can you suggest anything that we can do in the way of a repair to save some money?

Thanks, David in Watertown, SD.

Dear David,
New interior parts can be very expensive so many people leave their vehicles unrepaired. What's wrong with a seat and trim from another Tahoe of the same year that has no damage? Look into certified used parts. Ask your dealer if they can find these parts so you can get a repair that makes more financial sense. With the hundreds of reliable used parts sources in the country they should be able to find a match for a late model vehicle like yours and make the repair affordable. There is always a way.

Dear Motor Medics,
We have a 2012 Hyundai Santa Fe that has been having the check brake light come on periodically. The fluid tank slowly drains so we fill the brake fluid and it works fine for a while then comes on again. We had a mechanic look at it and tell us we would have to replace the HCU in the brake system and that the part alone is about \$1600.00. Is this a common problem and does this sound reasonable? Is there anything else we can do? I'm a little hesitant to spend so much on a repair on a 10-year-old vehicle, when the value is maybe a little more than twice the cost to repair the problem.

Kay in Nebraska

Dear Kay,
The HCU is the Hydraulic Control Unit and it's the main component of the anti-lock brake system. The units don't tend to leak fluid but rather fail electrically so I would take a very close look at the lines going to the unit which are more common to fail. Shop around for brakes. A second opinion never hurts if you have any question and by asking us, we assume that you do. When you have an older vehicle or any vehicle for that matter it is important to keep repairs economical but it's also important to be safe. Brakes are not an area to cut corners on but there are always ways to save money when repairing them.

Minnehaha County Commission meetings moved to Carnegie Hall The Minnehaha County

Commission will hold their June 21, 28, and July 5 meetings at Carnegie Hall, 235 W. 10th St. Sioux Falls. These meetings will be uploaded to the County YouTube page for viewing. The meeting will be available to stream from the //siouxfalls.org/meetings webpage. All meeting materials will be available on the County website. This temporary relocation will allow construction crews to begin renovating the existing chambers into


