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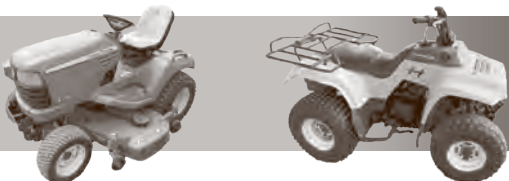
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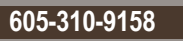

All the led lights contained in the unit are as one piece and the unit must be replaced. To save some cash on both parts try a certified auto recycler near you. They can save you a lot.

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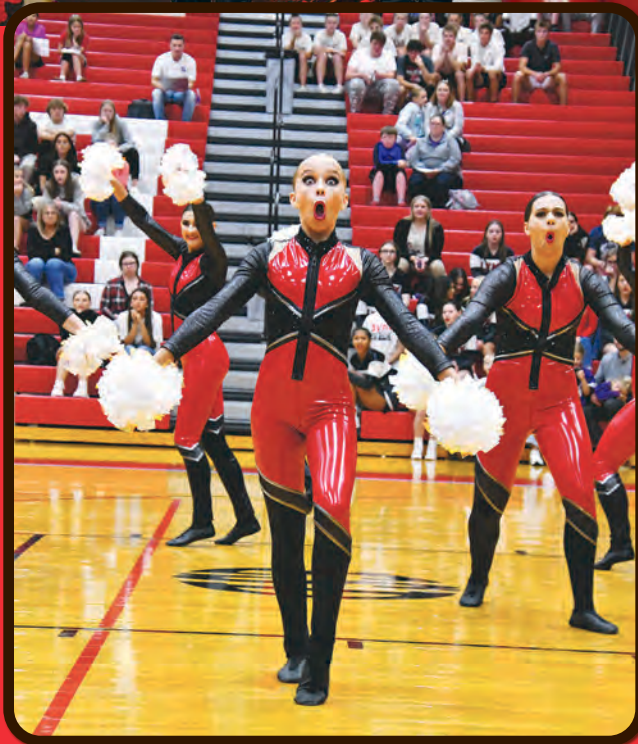
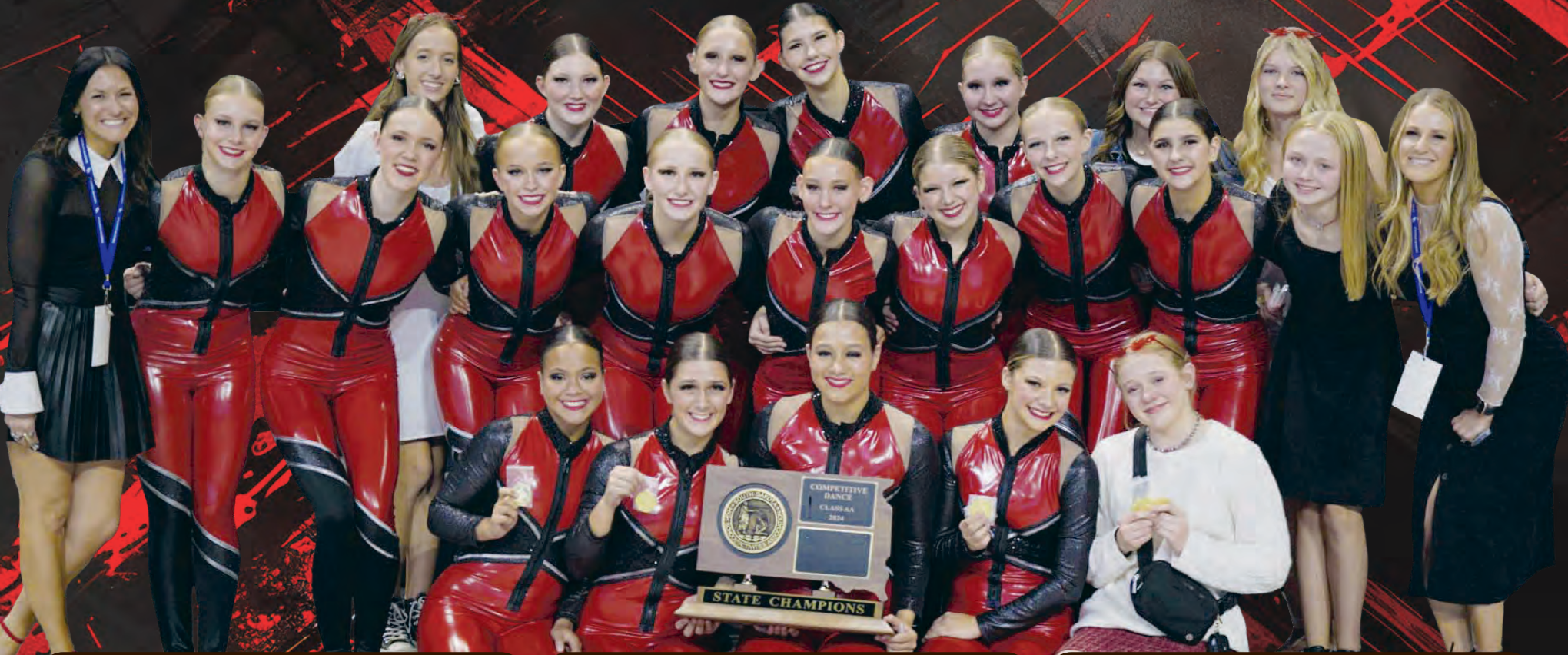

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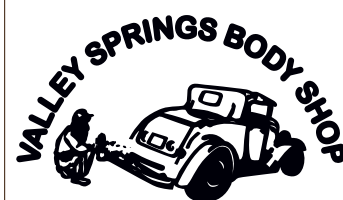
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
